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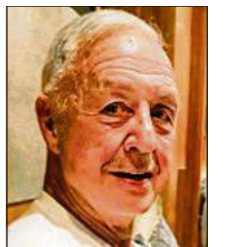

Kerry County Council and Cork County Council In accordance with sub-section 2(b) of 37F of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 as amended, Cummeannabudodge Wind DAC gives notice of its furnishing of significant additional information to An Coimisiún Pleanála in relation to the following proposed development:

10 year planning permission for wind energy development consisting of 17 no. wind turbines and related works located on land at Cummeannabudodge (County Kerry), Cychaghróe (County Kerry), Glashacormick (County Kerry), Cummeannavrick (County Kerry), and Caherdowney (County Cork).

An Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) and a Natura Impact Statement (NIS) were submitted as part of this application.

- (ii) The likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, if carried out.

(iii) The likely significant effects of the proposed development on a European site, if carried out.

Any submissions/observations must be accompanied by a fee of €50 (except for certain prescribed bodies). There is no fee required to make a submission in relation to those parties/individuals who have already made a valid written submission to the Commission regarding the application. Submissions or observations must be received by the Commission no later than 5.30 p.m. on the 01st July 2026.

Such submissions/observations must also include the following information:

- (i) The name of the person making the submission or observation, the name of the person acting on his or her behalf, if any, and the address to which any correspondence relating to the application should be sent.
- (ii) The subject matter of the submission or observation, and
- (iii) The reasons, considerations and arguments on which the submission or observation is based in full.
